ACCEPTABLE ITEMS: **CRT's** - Computer monitors & TVs
Batteries - Metal hydride, Ni-Cad, small sealed lead acid, Lithium, mercuric and silver oxide button batteries.
Mercury Switches – Fever and cooking thermometers, Thermostats, weather barometers and blood pressure cuffs.
Lamps – Fluorescent, neon, mercury vapor, metal halide, high Intensity discharge and high pressure sodium lamps. Basically all light bulbs except incandescent.

HOURS OF OPERATION: May through October: The 3rd weekend of the month
Hours: 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM on Saturdays and 8:00 AM to 2:00 PM on Sundays
Closed: November through April

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

- Burn Pile** Brush & trees up to 4 inches
Boards with no nails or paint
- Metal Pile** All white metal goods, refrigerators, freezers, washers,
dryers, etc. *Charge of \$15.00 for any item containing Freon.*
- Hot Loads** Ashes from stoves
- Compost** Leaves, grass, veggies, etc.
- Demo Debris** Household goods, sheetrock, couches, chairs, plastic
- Shingles** Requires pre-approval through Penobscot County

NON-ACCEPTABLE ITEMS: Truck or car batteries
Propane tanks
Tires
