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Dear Unorganized Territory Property Owner:

The State of Maine has modernized its decades-old tax system to make it easier, faster, and more convenient to file, pay, and manage state taxes.

The new system, called the Maine Tax Portal, allows taxpayers and tax professionals to file and pay state taxes, update account details, and view notices from Maine Revenue Services 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

Maine Revenue Services (MRS) is pleased to announce that on October 15, 2024, the Maine Tax Portal will become available for Unorganized Territory property services. Property owners and property lessees are encouraged to submit their Annual Inventory form and pay their taxes electronically for the first time, beginning on or after October 15, 2024.



Here is what you need to do:

- 1. Sign up for an upcoming Maine Tax Portal training webinar.**
MRS will host free, live specialized training webinars for Unorganized Territory property owners and property lessees, on October 24, 2024 or October 31, 2024 (you only need to attend one session) – see the schedule online and register at maine.gov/revenue/portal.
- 2. Begin using the Maine Tax Portal to remit Unorganized Territory property tax payments on October 15, 2024.**
 - Go to revenue.maine.gov, locate the Property Taxes panel, click on the Unorganized Territory Actions and Applications link, and click on Make a Bill Payment. You will be prompted to enter the Letter ID and Letter Date from the property tax bill you received.
 - You do not need to create a Maine Tax Portal username or account to pay your Unorganized Territory property taxes.
